New Plants have been added

Several new plants have been added to Cascade Carnivores' website, so be sure to check out our new stock items. New Pinguicula (Butterworts) and Nepenthes are now available. These include [Pinguicula sp. Lautner](#), and [Pinguicula macrophylla](#), [Nepenthes argentii](#) and [Nepenthes fallax](#). Actually, Nepenthes fallax was previously listed on our site as Nepenthes stenophylla. This species name is being officially changed to N. fallax. I have relisted this species, because the plants have been pitching heavily and it is deserving of being showcased this month.

Nepenthes fallax/Nepenthes stenophylla

As mentioned above, the name of the tropical pitcher plant from Borneo previously listed on Cascade Carnivores website as Nepenthes stenophylla, has been changed to N. fallax. The naming issue is not completely resolved, so you will see this species listed elsewhere using either name. It is an easy and moderate to fast grower. It has hairy leaves and pitchers, and the detailed patterns on the lids are unreal! We have these in stock and ready to ship.
